

Things Your Child Will Need for Kindergarten

Please label the following:

1. Please send an extra change of clothes in a bag for your child and mark his/her name clearly on the items. Include such things as a T-shirt, pants, under-pants, and 2 pairs of socks.
2. Your child will need a plain shirt - an old shirt of Dad's will be fine.
3. Your child will need a pair of runners for gym, to be left at the school. Please send the slip-on kind or Velcro. PLEASE NO TIE SHOES
4. Since Kindergarten is a full day, we have lunch and a morning snack. In order to avoid confusing snacks with lunches, please send the snack in a separate bag and label "snack" right on the snack itself. Please send healthy snacks and lunches, no candy, chocolate or junk food.
5. A large backpack used to carry things to and from Kindergarten each day.
6. Large Hilroy Scrapbook (coil binding - blue color).
7. A plastic cup so they can get drinks of water from the sink in the classroom.
8. Helmet and skates for school skating when needed.
9. Earphones for Computer class (please do not send ear buds they don't fit in their ears properly).
10. Garden gloves (for outdoor classroom use).

The items below do not need to be labeled as they will be used collectively as a class.

11. Three sharpened pencils (Venus Brand).
12. One white eraser.
13. Three large glue sticks.
14. Crayola Markers 8-12.
15. Ziploc bags - 2 sandwich size and 1 large.
16. One box of Kleenex.
17. One unlined small Hilroy notebook
18. Check the following list. Please bring the item that corresponds with the first letter of your last name: (ex. **S**mith = one package of plastic spoons)
A-B – one package of bandaids (Band Aid brand)
C-G – \$2 for hand sanitizer (I will purchase a large bottle for the classroom)
H-M – one package of plastic forks
N-W – one package of plastic spoons

Please label all outdoor clothing, and rain or winter boots with your child's name.

Please consider providing the school with a Criminal Records Check. This will ensure you are ready for any volunteer work such as classroom help or field trips at the school.
