Standing Agenda Items

School Report – Chris shared Our School Survey results. Elementary results represent Grades 4-6, High School results represent Grades 7-8. Survey is completed by all students in the division. Chris noted that the results are similar to last year. Did notice higher levels of anxiety, but that is consistent with other schools. The small class sizes in Grade 7 & 8 have impacted some of the results. Chris will be meeting with Valley Manor and Venture principals to discuss results in the city.

\$350 was collected at the Christmas Concert cookies and hot chocolate event. Money was donated to the Martensville Free Pantry to purchase fresh fruit and vegetables as needed.

Milk Program – Chris will talk to the teachers and have a class take charge of this activity. Punch cards are already made. SCC members will help if needed.

Trustee's Report – Budget planning will be starting at the end of this month. Celebration of Learning Gala is January 31 in Warman. There will be displays and performances. Tickets are \$30.

Fundraising – Chris reinforced his hope that the SCC will not focus too much on fundraising. He is pleased with the efforts being made to pay for the playground and feels SCC time and effort should be focused on educational and school goals. Decision to continue with one SCC fundraiser in the Fall, may continue with vegetables – want to remain community focused. School may do a Spring fundraiser with

proceeds to support field trips, classroom libraries and consumables. SCC will help as needed. Melissa Zimmer has agreed to chair the SCC fundraising committee. Decisions about Fall event will need to be made before the end of the school year.
