Old Business

1. Regional Kids First Day Volunteers – Chris/Ashley

School Report: Chris Mason/Amy Orth

Chris: 52 kindergarten registrations so far, badminton in full swing with playoffs in Duck Lake on Monday, Grade 1 class is hatching chicks, Track and Field dates on the calendar are not accurate – more details will be coming out closer, swimming dates for June have been booked, June 25 Grade 8 farewell, most other field trips are already on the website

Amy: next meeting we'll be discussing some more around family engagement in preparation for the May meeting of all PSSD schools, staffing updates will happen as numbers for next year come together. The school team getting ready for the changes in Rosthern is very interested in how things were done at Lake Vista and how they might structure things when they combine k-12.

Trustee's Report: Bonnie Hope

Rural congress event happened last week, Martensville Business Expo is this weekend and the Foundation will have a booth, June 11 golf tournament (Foundation), Rosthern school project on track for fall 2020 occupancy, likely no AGM this year (no longer required, and low attendance at the last one), Provincial budget impacts are yet to be fully realized, provincial school boards association meeting is next week in Saskatoon.

Parent/Community Engagement: Cara

Cara highlighted the flip charts that were out during P/T Interviews, and some of the information that came out of them is being included in the survey that is going out. Possibilities of smaller/mini-sessions to get information out/opportunity to learn.

Ask that if anyone on the SCC has community contacts get in touch with Cara to put together so we can provide it to the school too for teachers to access when they're looking to bring people into the school, etc.

Discussion to send out a thank you to the parents who volunteer, ie : logo card and lanyard? See if teachers are on board to have students make cards?

New Business

1. Presentation of Proposal – Jill
 - a. Lake Vista School – Decals, proposed costs included in information passed around. Submit quote ideas for the 24" x 4" quote (decal 1) to Jill. Quotes from Imagine That in Saskatoon. Total estimated cost \$900. MOTION: Cara: that the SCC approve the proposal of \$900 to have the three decals made for the school this year, Seconded: by Stacy. In favour: Unanimous CARRIED.
2. Track and Field – SCC role?
 - a. Chris will get the dates to Ashley and what kind of parent help will be needed. 2 different track meets, gr 4-6 and gr 7-8.
3. Talent Night – Amy
 - a. Last year Taylor was able to do a lot of work with the talent night. Amy, Tara, Brenna, and Jessica are willing to help with this year, but are concerned about the amount of

time they each have during the day to be able to support the students in preparing for the show. Amy will send an email to Ashley to send out for parent volunteers, and send out on the school blog to see about getting some parents to conduct auditions, rehearsals, etc. Decision on whether or not to have a talent night this year will then be made based on response received.

4. Upcoming SCC AGM and election
 - a. May 16th and Ashley will send out the details
5. Motion to pay babysitter Motion by Desirae, seconded by Melissa 1.5 hours at \$10/hour (\$15), in favour: Unanimous CARRIED.
 - a. Future meetings, ask anyone needing childcare to email Ashley or Cara (send that out too on the school announcements) so we can plan appropriately
6. Other
 - a. Playground update: \$64,731.10 carry forward from 2018, fundraising so far this year has brought it down to \$56, 898.97 owing.
