Please register your child for Kindergarten for the upcoming school year!

In Prairie Spirit School Division, your child must be 5 years of age by December 31, 2019 to register for Kindergarten.

Allan School Pre-Kindergarten Applications for School Year 2019-2020

Application forms for the next school year are now available at the school office.

The Pre-Kindergarten program is designed for children who are 3 and 4 years old. A child who demonstrates a challenge in the area of social, behavioural, emotional, cognitive or communicative skills will be given priority. Other determining factors that are specific to each child will also be taken into consideration.

The aim of the Pre-Kindergarten program is to give children the opportunity to start Kindergarten with the social, emotional and cognitive skills necessary to succeed. A better beginning with formal education will help to ensure a better future.
