Our Borden School staff continues to work diligently and purposefully as a team. Our focus throughout December has narrowed down on 2 topics. First of all, assessment. Currently, our mission is working towards increasing alignment between teachers so that families can expect consistent reporting regardless of the teacher or grade. Unity and alignment are important traits that successful schools possess. We are working to enhance that unity and alignment through our assessment practices.

The next topic that we are excited to jump into is *Kelso's Choices*. *Kelso's Choices* is a social conflict resolution program that is geared toward elementary age students. Our staff believes that this program will aid our students in their own social *Problem Solving*. Problem solving is one of our core goals, so we believe that this program will be tremendously beneficial for our students. Our K-8 students will begin their work on *Kelso's Choices* first thing in January.

In the New Year, our staff will also be working on establishing a clear literacy plan for struggling readers beyond grade 3. As it stands, students in Prairie Spirit have official reading level tests from grades 1-3. Our mission will be to carry on the purposeful literacy work and interventions for struggling readers beyond grade 3. Reading is one of the most important skills that students will learn at school, so we are going to construct intentional interventions and assessments for all our struggling readers beyond grade 3.
