- 1) The school will be open and operating as per usual during these cold weather days. Course work and assignments will advance even during cold weather days.
- 2) Please be sure that students that are being transported to school by private vehicle do not arrive before 8:20 AM.
- 3) Students from K-6 will have indoor recess breaks (the gym is made available for physical activities) when the combined temperature is -25°.
