## **Bell Schedule:**

Next year, the school day is being lengthened by 3 minutes to a total of 315 instructional minutes in all Prairie Spirit School Division schools. This is the daily schedule for the 2021-2022 school year at Borden School:

#### Phys. Ed Training:

Sadly, there will be no Track & Field days or events at Borden School this year. Having said that, all of our Phys. Ed teachers have made a plan to practice, develop skills, and showcase skills within their Phys. Ed programs. Although this will not replace the event and the excitement of previous years, there will still be skills taught and competitions held (within cohorts).

#### **Hot Weather Precautions:**

In the same way that we have asked families to ensure adequate winter clothing, we are also asking that families are mindful of the heat. Please ensure that your children have a hat, sunscreen, and a functioning water bottle to help outdoor time on hot/sunny days be as safe and enjoyable as possible. ## Final Day of School for K-8 Students:

The Final Day of school for K-8 students is Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup>. Progress Reports will be sent home for K-8 students on June 28<sup>th</sup> at the end of the school day. Families of students who are absent on the 28<sup>th</sup> will have Progress Reports emailed to them (physical copies can be distributed in the fall).

#### Final Exams 2021:

The Final Exam schedule for Grade 10-12 in the 2021 school year will be as follows: Thursday, June 24<sup>th</sup> – Math (all Grade 10-12 students in a math class will write their final this day) Friday, June 25<sup>th</sup> – Biology 30 Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup> – Chemistry 30 If students are not in the class with the scheduled final, they are not required to come to school those days (Grade 10 students have no finals on Friday, June 25<sup>th</sup> or on Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup>, and not every grade 11-12 student is taking both Bio and Chem).

Progress Reports for High School students will be available on Tuesday, June 29<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM. Families and students who are unable to pick up during that narrow timeframe will have progress reports emailed to them (physical copies can be distributed in the fall).

## PAA in 2021-2022:

Students in Grades 7-10 will be required to take Practical and Applies Arts courses next year (these courses are Industrial Arts and Home Economics). Students in Grades 11-12 will have the option to take PAA courses next year.

At the time of writing this, students are still not able to travel on buses as a COVID restriction. If/when this restriction is lifted, the plan is to have students once again commute by bus to Langham for their PAA instruction.
