Dear Borden School Families,

We have returned from the February Break and resumed the important work of learning and growing without really skipping a beat! 3-Way Conferences:

Masks:

As you are all well aware, masks in school are now completely optional. I am happy to say that to my knowledge so far, the individual choices of students and staff have been respected and accepted around the whole school. I view this as a sign of the amazing work by parents and the community to allow for open-minded thinking in our whole student body. As a staff, our goal is to create a safe place for all students, and this includes their choice to be masked or unmasked. We thank you for your continued support and acceptance in this regard.

Illness at School:

As the province has dropped covid restrictions, I thought it would be important to share one expectation that will continue at Prairie Spirit School Division schools. Students who are obviously ill and their symptoms cannot be explained (allergies, cold induced runny noses, or exercise induced coughing as examples) will still be sent home.

There are elements of professional judgement that go into this at the school level. Borden School staff will contact families when students self-report symptoms directly, or if obvious indications of illness are persistent and incessant. Students are welcome to return to school as soon as they are symptom free.

We thank you for your support and understanding as we strive to keep everyone at Borden School healthy and safe.
