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Dear Borden School Families,

Returning from the April Break has brought Borden School into the final quarter of the school year. As we look back on the school year so far, there have been many highlights, obstacles overcome, and tremendous learning throughout the whole school. I am looking forward to the final months of the school year working alongside all our Borden Bruins!

#### Volunteers:

As we are nearing the time of year for Field Trips, we will be hoping to have parent volunteers attend and participate. It is crucially important that parent volunteers have their criminal record check and vulnerable sector check on file at the school.

In order to support this from the school, we have 2 avenues available for families. First of all, we have a letter that we can provide to parent volunteers which will prevent any cost to parents while getting these checks completed. We are also able to take completed forms, along with scans of a piece of photo I.D. + the volunteer's health card, in to the RCMP on your behalf. Again, this option would prevent any personal cost for parents who choose to do this.

I understand that this process is inconvenient, and we appreciate everyone who is able and willing to go through this process to volunteer at Borden School and for Borden School events/activities.

### **Awards Night:**

Borden School is excited at the prospect of hosting an in-person Awards Night again! We have set the date for Wednesday, June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022. More details will follow, but please save the date! We are hopeful to see as many of our families as possible!

#### **Grade 12 Graduation:**

The Grade 12 Graduation Ceremony is booked for Friday, June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at the Borden Community Centre. The program is open to the whole community, and it will begin at 7:00 PM. There is a dance to follow the program. I hope it works for folks to come and celebrate the achievement of our Borden Bruin Grade 12 students this year!

#### Track & Field:

Preparation for Track & Field across all grade levels is going strong already! Our Elementary School Track Day is set for Wednesday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022. As of typing this note, we are still uncertain if Perdue School will be attending, or if the event will be exclusively for Borden School students. Regardless, we are hopeful to have parents/guests attend and participate in the day! Be on the lookout for more information in the weeks leading up to June 1<sup>st</sup>.

For Grade 7-12, Track & Field practices are officially underway, and various events have been practiced in Phys. Ed class already. The Conference Meet for Grade 7-12 athletes will be on Thursday, May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The event will be held at the Gordie Howe Sports Complex in Saskatoon.

### **Pick-Up Reminders:**

I would like to remind and encourage all families to continue the practice of communicating clearly with both classroom teachers and office staff regarding early pick-up times for students.

Communicating all student drop-off or pick-up times which are outside the usual times helps everyone be prepared and efficient. At this time in the year, surprises and disruptions, no matter how minor, can ripple through classrooms. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding in maintaining the consistent and timely communication around student drop-off and pick-up.

### **Boys Washroom:**

The Boys Washroom at Borden School is an area where we are looking for family support. For a wide variety of reasons, the boys bathroom is an area that is difficult to supervise directly. It is also a challenging area because at a small, K-12 school with only one shared washroom, the difference in age between students in the washroom can be very large. This is the help we are looking for from parents:

- Review urinal etiquette with students (some younger students are still going pants to ankles at the urinal).
- Review how to use stall locks, and review the importance of respecting that a
  person inside a locked stall needs privacy.
- Review that the shared washroom is not a play area (we have some students yelling, screaming, climbing, crawling, and generally making an environment which can be really uncomfortable for others using the washroom).

We are addressing these issues at the school when they come up. We would really appreciate additional support from home to reinforce the importance of appropriate behaviour in this area of our school.

#### Mental Health Week:

### **RCMP Visit:**

On May 4<sup>th</sup>, 3 RCMP Officers were able to spend time at Borden School speaking with students. The RCMP Officers left feeling respected and valued, and our students from K-12 showed engagement and expressed positive comments about their time with RCMP Officers. I would encourage all families to ask about the experience your child(ren) had with the RCMP. I am grateful for the engagement of the Warman RCMP Detachment and their support of our students and school!

## **Breakfast Program Donations:**

Our Breakfast Program which runs on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays has been a big success this year! Mrs. Troupe-Logue, Mrs. Yuskiw, Mrs. Mikituk, Mr. Morris and Mrs. Lukan work together to support this program. At this point in the year, we are able to take donations again. Assorted items like juice boxes, banana loaves, muffins, fruit, cheese, yogurt, assorted baking, and monetary donations would all be gratefully accepted.

## Kindergarten Registration:

If you have a child who will be 5 years old by December 31st, 2022, you can register for Kindergarten now! Also, if you know of any families or community members who have children who will be 5 years old by December 31st, 2022, please encourage them to register or reach out to the school. We are always eager to get in touch with our newest crew of Borden Bruin students!

There has been a new step added for Kindergarten Registration by the ministry of education (which means this applies to all schools across Saskatchewan that have a Kindergarten program). Families are required to provide confirmation of either their Kindergarten Child's passport or birth certificate. This confirmation can be provided as part of the online registration (scanned and uploaded), or it can be provided in-person at the school with a visual confirmation by either Mrs. Angelena Lukan or Mr. Brody Morris. The reason for this is to guarantee birthdate and legal name for the ministry of education.
