

## Borden Lions Scholarship 2023 – 2024 – Information & Regulations

The value of the scholarship will be \$500, made possible by the Borden Lions and the former Langham Lions.

The scholarship may be awarded regardless of other scholarship(s) received by the applicant.

The applicant may have received the Borden Lions Scholarship in previous years.

Applicants must have a strong connection to the district served by the Borden Lions. Usually this will mean that the graduated from Borden School or W.W. Brown High School in Langham, but exceptions may be made at the discretion of the Borden Lions.

Applicants must have successfully completed at least one year of post-secondary studies (university, technical school or business college), and be enrolled for a minimum of 2 years.

An interview process may be used.

The deadline for applications is January 31, 2024.
