Planning for Next Year:

Kindergarten Registration:

If have not already completed the registration and if your child will be five years of age on or before December 31, 2024, it is time to register for Kindergarten.

To register, go to Prairie Spirit's Registration Page and choose the "Register to attend a Prairie Spirit School this Fall (Sept 2024)" link: **Register**.

Please note that you will need proof of student's legal name and age. Valid documents include:

- > Birth Certificate (preferred)
- Secure Certificate of Indian Status/Treaty Card
- Permanent Resident Card
- Passport
- Work/Study Permit
- Visitor Visa (Temp. Resident Visa)

If you have specific questions regarding student progress and learning, please follow this communication process:

- 1. The classroom teacher is to be the first person to hear and address any concerns from a student or parent.
- 2. If the issue cannot be resolved with the teacher in a reasonable amount of time, the principal may be contacted.
- 3. If the matter remains unresolved, the parent may request a meeting with the Superintendent.
- 4. If the matter remains unresolved, the parent may also request a hearing with the Director or Board of Education to further appeal the decision.

Awards Day:
