# Jr. & Sr. Track and Field (Grade 7-11):

Track and field season is upon us once again. Student sign-up started April 23rd/2024. If your child would like to participate in track this season, please have them sign up. We have several students signed up already and welcome everyone who would like to participate.

This year Ms. McGregor and Mrs. Kaufmann will be available to coach and organize, along with some other staff. We had our track and field clinic on April 12th/2024 to align with our Physical Education classes to ensure our athletes were able to participate in the clinic. Below is some key information for the season.

### Requirements

Students are expected to participate in at least 2 events with a maximum of 4 events. Relays do not count as events, and we would like to put together a relay team if we have the athletes available.

Students are also asked to attend a minimum of 2 practices before we attend conferences.

## Track Fees

Several expenses go with the track and field season. Each year there are meet fees and transportation costs, and this year we will be updating some of our equipment. It is for this reason that track fees will be increased to \$40 per child.

# Events

We have several new athletes this year, so we will be starting track season going through the events. We are hoping to go through the events at practice on Thursday, April 25th/2024. If your child must miss this practice, we can go through it at a different time.

Pole vaulting is an event offered through special programming. If this is something your child is interested in, please contact Ms. McGregor or Mrs. Kaufmann.

We can send 3 athletes per age group for each event. If there is an event where we have more than 3 students signed up in that age group, we will have an in-house school meet to determine who will advance to conferences. If this situation occurs you will be contacted before the school meet.
