Welcome Message:

Welcome back families! We are excited for another school year and we look forward to greeting your students on the 3rd of September. I hope all of you have had great summer breaks and that our students are rested and ready to go. New to our school this year will be Natalie Anderson, who will be teaching grade 7-8, Talon Hall, who will be teaching senior math and sciences, Rachel Baerg, who will be teaching grade 3-4, and MacKenzie Janzen, who is teaching Kindergarten; she is also our Learning Support Teacher. We also welcome back a familiar face, Gwen Dyck, who will be one of our Educational Associates.

Personal Electronic Devices in Borden School:

- 1. Phones and personal electronic devices are not to be used in classrooms during class unless used temporarily for a very specific purpose and permission has been given by the principal to do so.
- When entering a classroom, students must turn their phone OFF and place it in the phone daycare. They may pick it up upon exiting after the bell.
 Students may not have a phone on their person or within their reach during class.
- 3. Students may use their phones during non-instructional times such as breaks, at lunch, or on the bus.
- 4. If a student breaks these rules, the following will occur:
 - a. First offence teacher confiscates the phone and returns it at the end of the class period.
 - b. Second offence teacher confiscates the phone and it is held in the office until the end of the day when it can be picked up by the student.
 - c. Third offence phone will be held at the office until a parent comes to pick it up.

PAA:

Our grade 9-12 students will begin their PAA trips to Langham on the afternoon of September 3. Our 7/8 students will take PAA 'in-house' and remain in Borden this year. They will study a variety of modules all taken from Saskatchewan PAA curriculum guides including some wood-working, financial literacy, tourism, and Life Transitions.
