# National Day for Truth and Reconciliation:

(No School on Tuesday, September 30th)

Each year, September 30 marks the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, a day to honour the children who never returned home and honours the resilience, dignity, and strength of survivors of residential schools, as well as their families and communities.

In recognition of the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, our school's flags will be lowered to half-mast at the end of the day on Monday, September 29, and raised again on Wednesday morning when classes resume.
