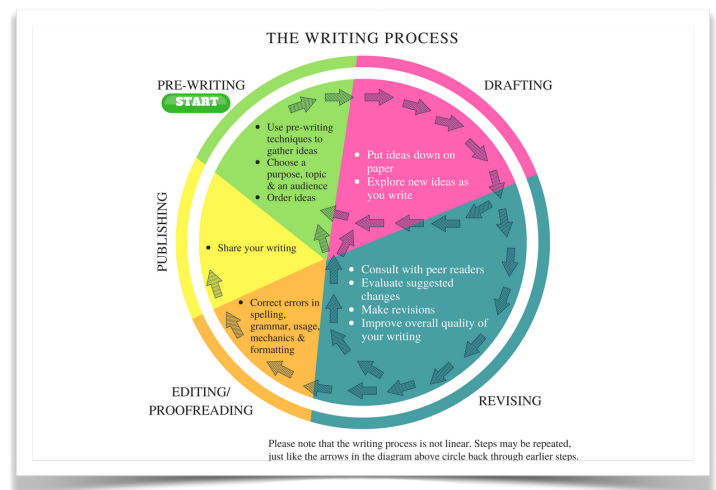
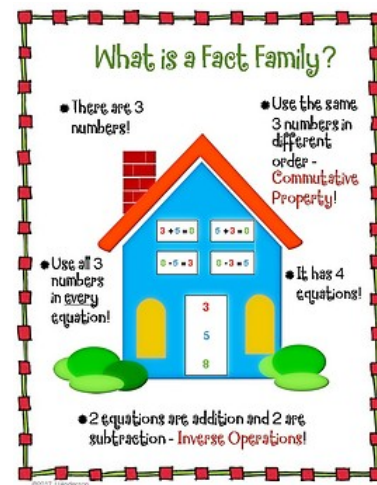
Math

Students are working on developing an understanding of “Fact Families” with addition and subtraction questions. They are gaining momentum to work their way up to a variety of adding and subtracting questions with answers up to 100.

ELA

We are working on phonemic awareness with vowel recognition, as well as adding and removing prefixes and suffixes. Students have also been introduced to the rules of pluralizing words.

Students are working through the writing process to create explanatory texts that teach the reader how to do something.
