COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

- -the Town of Delisle held a regular meeting on April 14th electronically over the internet.
- -the Town will allow the School Community Council to take approximately 1,500 cubic yards of fill at no charge to be used to create a man-made recreational hill on the school yard.
- -the Town will submit an Infrastructure Investment Plan under the Federal Gas Tax program for the proposed landscaping of the Highway Commercial property along Railway Avenue at an estimated total cost of \$500,000.
- -the Town will temporarily waive interest charges on outstanding water and sewer accounts starting March 31, 2020 and continuing on until further notice.
- -a bylaw was passed to change the property tax discount periods. For the year 2020 only, current municipal property tax payments received until the end of August will receive a 5% discount, a 4% discount during September, a 3% discount during October and a 2% discount during November. Property tax notices will not be mailed out until the beginning of June.
- -the Town of Delisle held a budget meeting on April 29th electronically over the internet.
- -the Town will subscribe so that CIBC & Scotiabank clients can pay their property taxes and water & sewer accounts through online banking
- a tender package will be prepared for the excavation and levelling of dirt for the new highway commercial lots along Railway Avenue
- -the 2^{nd} lift of pavement on the 100 Block of the 6^{th} Avenue East will be completed in 2020. Drainage will also be addressed at the 5^{th} Ave./ 6^{th} Ave. East intersection.
- -the low spot on Railway Avenue between the Town Office and the Esso will be addressed, possibly with a new cement swale.
- -both municipal and school mill rates for property taxes remain unchanged for 2020.
- -the 2020 budget was approved with a nominal surplus of \$290.
