Message from Admin:

I shared an analogy with our staff a couple of weeks ago and I would like to share it with you, our DES families. It is called the Wallet Analogy. I heard it a few years back while my wife Kelly was completing some schooling. The analogy goes like this.

As teachers we ask parents to trust us based upon our education and experience, not because we have earned their trust... and yet, every day they do it.

My connections to families were usually through the sports I coached because let's be honest, who comes to the Parent Teacher Interview with the Phys Ed teacher. This idea threw me for a loop, especially in a High School where we as parents tend to see this as a time for our children to be more independent. I thought to myself, how do I connect to families. Then I arrived at DES... I sent this to the staff because of all the work that they do to ensure that your precious children are cared for. I see it in every class and every decision. It's on the walls in our classrooms to the connections to families through emails, newsletters, and SeeSaw.

I hear it in the conversations our staff has about students and their learning journeys. Hearing successes and looking for student strengths. Collaborating and continuing our learning on how to best support all students understanding that every student is unique and is at a different place in this journey.

Most importantly, I see it in the smiles of the students and the laughter in the hallways. The struggles and triumphs. The friendships and the memories made. This is truly a great place.

I want to end by saying thank you to all our DES families. We understand the stresses that come with keeping children home, even if the symptoms seem minor. We are grateful for everyone in doing their best to keep our school safe for all who enter.

I have done voiceovers. You can hear my voice on an app where I've voiced numerous stories and book summaries.


