
School Skating 2024-2025





In recognition of the Sports Safety Policy, each student is required to wear a CSA approved helmet. Students are requested to bring their skates and helmet the day of their skating. For those students who do not have access to a helmet or skates, the school has a few extras to borrow for the day. This is part of the physical education curriculum for all grade levels.

Students in grades kindergarten, 1, 2, 2/3, and 3/4will be bussed to the rink. Students in grades 4, 5, 5/6, and 6 will walk as a group to the arena. Please ensure students are dressed appropriately and that skates and helmets are in a proper carrying bag.
