PreK Schedule: PreK will run **Tuesday to Friday from 8:40AM to 11:40AM**, pick up is 11:30 to 11:40 (follows the Prairie Spirit calendar for no school days during holidays, teacher prep, days in lieu, etc.).

PreK Supplies List:

- **Backpack** - to hold your child's snack, water bottle, library books, crafts, etc.
- **Indoor Shoes** - should be non-marking runners. Your child will put these on each day inside the school; they are intended for both classroom and gym use.
- **Snack (daily, nut-free)** – HES is a nut-aware environment and it is very important that snacks do not contain nuts. Some ideas for snacks are: veggies & dip, cut up fruit, yogurt, a muffin, a granola bar, cookies, etc.
- **Water bottle** – your child's water bottle will go to and from school each day.
- **Change of Clothes** – place in a large Ziplock bag labelled with the student's name. This bag will stay at school in case of bathroom or water mishaps, etc. when a change of clothes is needed.
- **Photos (2)** – Please email me a current photo of your child and a family photo. I will use their individual photo for labelling (ie: lockers), and I will put the family photo on a "Our PreK Families" bulletin board. My email is jenna.reimer@spiritsd.ca
