Swimming Lessons in Saskatoon



Lessons will run Friday mornings April 1-May 27 with a break on Good Friday and 2.5 hour recreational swim the week of Easter break.

Lessons are offered within a 2 hour block: 9-10:45 followed by a 45 minute rec swim. Your exact lesson times will be assigned once registration is complete. We honor requests to the extent we are able.

Registration is first come, first served. Our primary goal in making this activity available is to offer an opportunity for the broad homeschooling community to socialize and participate together. We prioritize lessons for families with older students over preschoolers.

Registration will open Friday, March 18.*Early registrations will be ignored.* The reason for this is that this notice is being circulated to 3 school divisions and includes families who do not use facebook. In order not to privilege a single group, we want to allow for adequate circulation of the notice.

To register, email your children's names and swim levels to homeschoolswimminglessons@gmail.com. Please also send an etransfer to the same email address for your lesson amount. If you cannot etransfer, you may drop a check at my saskatoon address. Email for that info.

Payment is required at registration. If you haven't paid, you are not registered.

Levels 5-8: \$85



Vaccines are no longer required; masks are required in common areas.

Instructors are NOT allowed in the water with swimmers so parents are required to be for levels up to Swim Kids 4. We will do our best to stagger your lessons or combine your children's levels so you can attend with all of them. If you wish to share water supervision with another parent, let us know who that is.

Please review all the guidelines and make sure you are willing to follow them. Lastly, due to a pool closure this summer, we will NOT offer lessons in the fall. Lessons over the next 2-3 years will be at a different facility and subject to our ability to book a pool and the number of instructors we require. We do not know at this point if that will be feasible.
