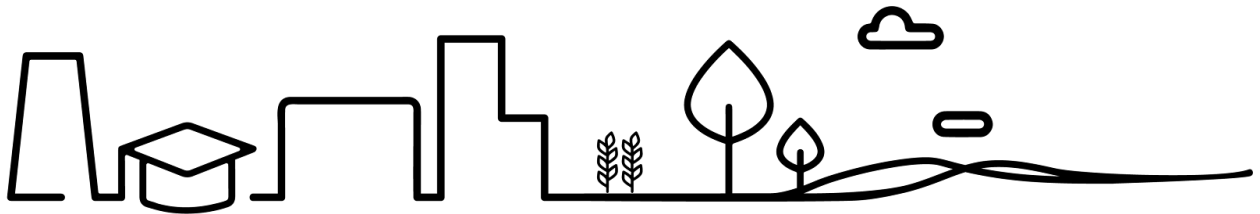

We are excited to announce that SUTIL will once again be hosting our **Grade 11 Virtual Fair on May 13, 2022 from 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM**. Here are the event details:

**FORMAT:** The fair will be hosted virtually through our [sutil.ca](https://sutil.ca) platform. Students will have access to short presentations, which will be scheduled throughout the entire day in a rotation of concurrent sessions. Here is the [tentative presentation schedule](#).

**PRESENTATION LENGTH:** 30 minutes total (15 minute presentation + 10 minutes for Q&A + 5 minutes to move to next session)

**HOW TO JOIN:** Students can, either individually or with classmates, visit the [sutil.ca](https://sutil.ca) website and click on the banner titled “*Grade 11 Virtual Career Fair*” (currently found under ‘*Virtual Booths*’ menu tab). This will connect them to a **Google Doc** that lists each presenter and the time they are presenting at (see example of tentative schedule above). When they click on their institution of choice from the list, they will then immediately join that institution's virtual booth. The virtual meeting space can then be accessed by selecting the button on the virtual booth titled “Join our Virtual Presentation.”
