For our grade 7, 8, 9 students our goal this year is to help our students develop in the following areas:



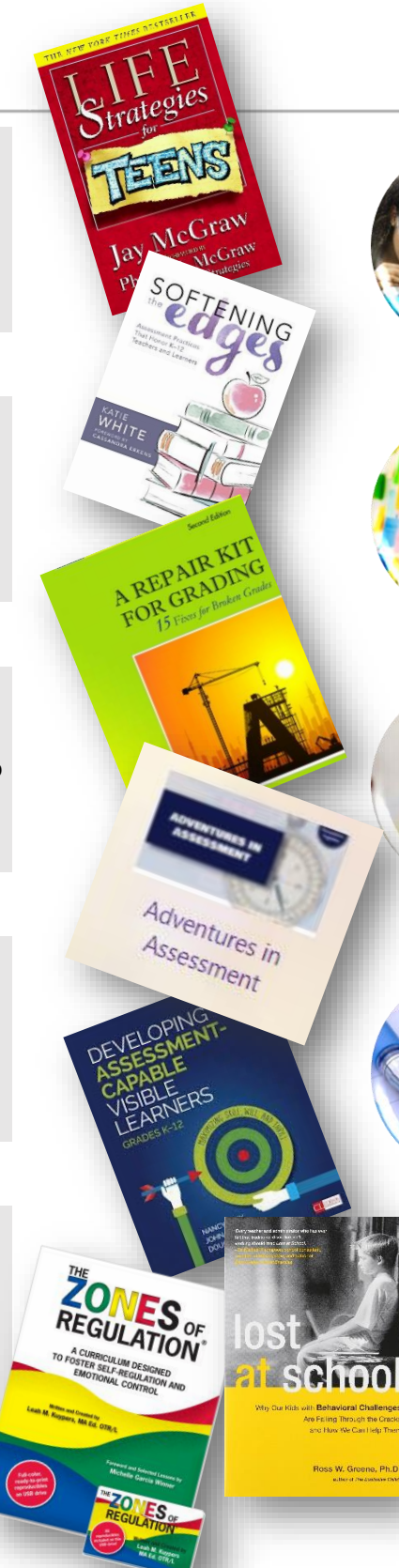
Resilience: how do we keep going when the 'going gets rough'? How do we build this in our students?
