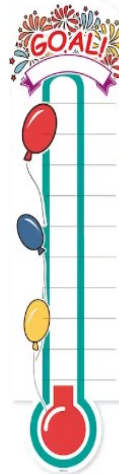

Join us this summer on the Wheatland Storybook Trail located in Veterans Square. Visit anytime, weather permitting us to keep the panels out.

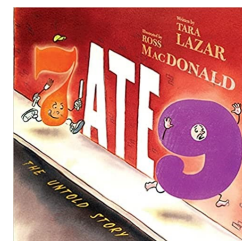
