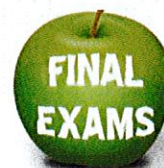

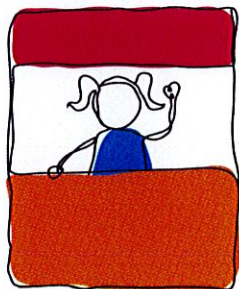
Extracurricular







