Immigration Status Descriptions

Canadian Citizen - A student born in Canada or has acquired Canadian citizenship.

Permanent Resident - A student or a student whose parent is granted long-term Permanent Resident Status in Canada by immigrating to Canada or as a refugee but has not yet become a Canadian citizen.

Refugee - A student or a student whose parent self-delcares as a person protected from harm and may be granted automatic Permanent Resident status.

Temporary Resident - A student who resides with a parent with a valid work permit issued by the Government of Canada or a student who resides with a parent who has a valid study permit and is registered in a recognized full-time degree or diploma program in Saskatchewan, other than an EAL program.

First Nations Data Descriptions

On Reserve - A student is considered on reserve when they live at a civic address on a reserve.

Off Reserve - A student is considered off reserve when attending a public school and living in the community of the school.
