# **Other Features of PowerParent**

When you first log into PowerParent – the opening page is often set to the Grades and Attendance page. It is each school's choice as to what is the first page. On the left side of the page is the navigation bar – the icons that appear on this menu is also dependent upon school choice.

- 1. Grades and Attendance:
- Anything **blue** is **clickable**. The Q1/Q2 etc are the terms that are recorded (Q1 represents the first quarter, S1 would be first semester, Y1 would be the cumulative mark for the year long classes and so on T1/T2/T3 represent terms if there are only 3 terms in the year)
- Click on a blue mark in the term column and see the individual assignment marks.
- Click on a blue attendance total and see the dates absent and the corresponding absence codes. A legend of the absence codes is at the bottom of the screen.
- Click the teachers name and email your questions or comments to them personally.

## **Outcomes Tab**

At the top of the Grades and Attendance Page is also the Outcomes Grades tab. On this page are the outcomes that are used for evaluating student progress. In Grades K - 9, outcomes are reported for each course and behaviours are also assessed and recorded here. In Grades 10 -12 – just behavior grades are reported here.

• Click on the blue Outcome for more details – choose Outcomes Grades Classic View from bottom right corner of page to get a clearer view of outcomes grades.

## 2. Grades History

Grades history shows the marks that would be displayed on a regular paper copy of a report card and are a snapshot of the student's mark on the day that the marks are stored.

Click on a blue percent mark and see the individual assignment marks. For students in Grades
 K-8 – a percentage mark may appear, but since all courses are only evaluated by outcomes, an overall mark in this area is not indicative of the student progress.

### 3. Attendance History

Attendance History displays the student's day by day, course by course, attendance with absence codes, but only for the current semester – the legend at the bottom of the screen identifies the codes used.
