

LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS

MARTENSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL, 2017 – 2018

Grade 12 Students

Application Deadline: <u>Wednesday, May 23, 2018</u>

- > There are several local scholarships available to current Grade 12 students.
- > <u>All</u> of these scholarships require completion of an application form.
- > **Most**, but not all, require proof of acceptance to a post-secondary program.
- > Application forms are available from Ms. Cooper or Mrs. MacKenzie
- All application forms must be submitted to Ms. Cooper or Mrs. MacKenzie by 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday, May 23, 2018 unless otherwise indicated.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

1. MARTENSVILLE COMMUNITY RECREATION PROJECT SCHOLARSHIPS

(up to \$1000)



- The Martensville Community Recreation Project is awarding \$2,000 worth of scholarship funding.
- Eligibility: Applicants must be pursuing post-secondary education in the fall of 2018. Preference will be given to students who have volunteered to help promote sport in the City of Martensville at the community or high school level. This can be through coaching, managing, officiating and growing sports in Martensville.
- > Applicants must complete the application form <u>and</u> provide:
 - o a cover letter
 - \circ a reference letter (from a teacher, coach, or community member) and
 - a copy of their current high school transcript and second semester mid-term marks (students' average will be calculated based on 8 courses: ELA A30; ELA B30; History 30/Native Studies 30/ or any other 30-level Social Science; a 20 or 30-level Science; a 20 or 30-level Math and 2 other 30-level academic courses).
- > <u>NOTE</u>: The recipient <u>must</u> be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2018.
- > The deadline to apply is Friday, May 11, 2018.

2. MARTENSVILLE VETERINARY HOSPITAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

- Eligibility: This award is given to the student with the highest average in Physics 30, Chemistry 30, and Biology 30.
- > <u>NOTE</u>: The recipient does <u>not</u> need to be attending post-secondary.

3. MARTENSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL STAFF SCHOLARSHIP (\$400)



- *Eligibility:* Applicant does not have to be a top student, but must demonstrate determination and great effort in achieving the level of marks obtained in high school.
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- > <u>NOTE</u>: The recipient <u>must</u> be attending post-secondary within the next 2 years.

4. BUSTER DAYS COMMITTEE SCHOLARSHIP (\$200)

- > Eligibility: Applicant must be a Grade 12 student who:
 - i. is going into a post-secondary program with a focus on sport, recreation, community development or business; and
 - ii. provides evidence of volunteer work (school-related and in the community) throughout their high school years.
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a postsecondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- > <u>NOTE</u>: The recipient <u>must</u> be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2018.

5. MARTENSVILLE DENTAL CLINIC SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000)

- Eligibility: Applicant must have taken <u>one</u> of the following Math pathways at the 20 & 30 levels (Foundations of Math 20 & Foundations of Math 30, <u>or</u> Pre-Calculus 20, Pre-Calculus 30 and Calculus) **and** <u>all</u> Sciences at the 20 and 30 levels as follows: at least one of Biology 20, Environmental Science 20 or Health Science 20 <u>and</u> Biology 30, <u>and</u> Physical Science 20, Chemistry 30 and Physics 30) <u>and</u> be entering a health science career of some kind.
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- > <u>NOTE</u>: The recipient <u>must</u> be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2018.

6. CITY OF MARTENSVILLE STUDENT BURSARY (\$400)

- Eligibility: Applicant must have an accumulated grade-point average high enough to qualify for entrance into a post-secondary program. The selection criteria will include academic merit as evidenced by a significant improvement in academic work and/or a demonstrated and sustained effort to maintain passing grades. Applicant must also provide evidence of involvement in extra-curricular and/or community activities.
- NOTE: The recipient must provide proof of enrolment in a post-secondary program within 6 months of graduating from high school.

7. MARTENSVILLE LADIES' NIGHT COMMITTEE SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)



- Eligibility: Applicant must be a female Grade 12 student who has: (i) been active as a volunteer in the school and the community during her high school years; (ii) has demonstrated congeniality; (iii) demonstrates financial need; and (iv) is pursuing post-secondary studies in the fall of 2018.
- To receive the scholarship, proof of enrolment in a post-secondary program must be supplied to the school.
- ▶ *NOTE*: The recipient must be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2018.

8. BOEHMS' PHYSIOTHERAPY ACADEMIC/ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)



- Eligibility: Applicants must demonstrate excellence in their dedication to both academic and athletic involvement. Consistent dedication to academics must be present but marks do not necessarily have to be the highest. Involvement in sports, in or out of school as an athlete, coach, or volunteer, must be demonstrated throughout their high school years.
- The recipient will be a future leader in society due to a commitment to sport and academics and will become a role model for young and old, alike.
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- > <u>NOTE</u>: the recipient <u>must</u> be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2018.

9. MHS STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)



- Eligibility: The applicant must have made an outstanding contribution to the student body at MHS and have been a member of the SRC for a period of at least one school year during his or her time at MHS.
 - Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
 - NOTE: the recipient <u>must</u> be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2018.

10. RICK CRANSTON SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

- Eligibility: The recipient will be a Grade 12 student with honours average in English Language Arts (marks for A10, B10, 20, A30 and B30 combined). The recipient must also demonstrate a passion for English Language Arts.
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- > <u>NOTE</u>: the recipient <u>must</u> be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2018.

11. MARTENSVILLE MESSENGER SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

Eligibility: Applicants must demonstrate an interest in academics with an English



- Language Arts, Mixed Media or Communications focus. Consistent **ARTENSVILLE** dedication to academics must be present but marks do not necessarily SENGER have to be the highest.
- > The recipient must have a plan or interest in pursuing a career in Media, Journalism or Communications and must also demonstrate community involvement.
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- > NOTE: the recipient must be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2018.

12. KINSMEN SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

- Eligibility: Applicant must be a prominent participant in extra-curricular activities that enrich both the school and the community.
- <u>NOTE</u>: The recipient <u>must</u> be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2018.

13. The Rick Cranston Extra Curricular Drama Award (\$300)

- Eligibility: Applicant must be in grade eleven or twelve and exhibit a passion for drama and a dedication to working with the group to make the production(s) a success. The applicant can come from any aspect of the extra curricular drama (stage crew, actor, etc.)
- NOTE: The recipient does not need to be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2018.



14. A & W SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)



- Eligibility: Applicants must demonstrate an interest or experience in food service and have the highest mark in either Food Studies 30 (or Practical and Applied Arts Survey A30) or Commercial Cooking 20.
 - <u>NOTE</u>: the recipient does <u>not</u> need to be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2018.

15. THE ABE REDDEKOPP SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

This scholarship is in honor of Abe Reddekopp, a man who valued hard work and fairness and who was generous with his time and talent in striving to do his best on each job. Abe was a proud member of the UA Local 179, whose objective is to represent all workers in the plumbing and pipefitting industry in providing the highest standards of quality workmanship and production.



- Eligibility: The recipient will be a Grade 12 student who (i) demonstrates the characteristics of Abe Reddekopp, (ii) participated in the Saskatchewan Youth Apprenticeship Program (iii) completed Apprenticeship or Career & Work Exploration with a work placement in a designated trade while in high school, and (iv) will be pursuing a designated trade after high school.
- To receive the scholarship, proof of registration with the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission or proof of acceptance into a pre-employment program at a post-secondary institution for the fall of 2018 must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- NOTE: The recipient <u>must</u> be registered to apprentice in a designated trade by the fall of 2018 or be registered to attend a pre-employment program at a post-secondary institution for the fall of 2018. Preference will be given to applicants who will be pursuing plumbing, pipe-fitting, welding, or steam-fitting.

16. MARTENSVILLE PLUMBING & HEATING SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

> Eligibility: The recipient will be a Grade 12 student who (i) participated in the



Saskatchewan Youth Apprenticeship Program and/or (iii) completed Apprenticeship or Career & Work Exploration with a work placement in a designated trade while in high school, and (iii) will be pursuing a designated trade after high school.

- To receive the scholarship, proof of registration with the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission must be supplied to the school (MHS) or the student must provide proof of acceptance into a pre-employment program at Saskatchewan PolyTechnic.
- NOTE: The recipient <u>must</u> be registered to apprentice in a designated trade by the fall of 2018 or be registered to attend a pre-employment trades program at a post-secondary institution in the fall of 2018. While preference will be given to applicants who will be pursuing a plumbing & heating trade, this scholarship is open to students pursuing any designated trade.

17. PROTECTIVE SERVICES SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

- The Martensville Fire Department is pleased to offer a \$500 scholarship as part of their ongoing community involvement.
- *Eligibility:* The recipient will be a Grade 12 student who:



- will be entering:
 - a. a post-secondary program in the Protective Services field as one of the following: firefighter, EMT or paramedic, police officer, conservation officer, etc. OR
 - b. the Armed Forces;
- (ii) has been active as a volunteer in his or her community; and(iii) is a multi-faceted individual.
- Two letters of recommendation must also be supplied in support of the student's application.
- To receive the scholarship, proof of acceptance into a post-secondary program in a Protective Services field or proof of acceptance into the Armed Forces must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- NOTE: The recipient <u>must</u> be registered in a post-secondary program in a Protective Services field by the fall of 2018 or be registered in the Armed Forces for the fall of 2018.



18. THE JUDY KOLACH SCHOLARSHIP (\$300)

- This scholarship is provided by the Kolach family (Alvin, Haley and Mary) in memory of Judy Kolach, who was a Special Education Resource Teacher at MHS for many years as well as a teacher and leader in Special Education within other schools in Prairie Spirit School Division.
- Eligibility: Applicant must be a Grade 12 student who:
 - is going on to post-secondary in the fall of 2018;
 - demonstrates involvement in extra-curricular activities while maintaining successful academic standing in high school;
 - has volunteered in the community while in high school;
 - shows a commitment to creating an environment of empathy and kindness; and
 - \circ $\;$ has overcome or faced a challenge.



- > Preference will be given to applicants who will be pursuing a Bachelor of Education program.
- > <u>NOTE</u>: The recipient <u>must</u> be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2018.

19. MARTENSVILLE BUILDING AND HOME SUPPLY SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)



INSURANCE

- Eligibility: The applicant must be a Grade 12 student who:
 - demonstrates an interest and/or experience in a construction or building-related trade or career path;
 - has taken Practical & Applied Arts B10, B20, and/or B30 (Industrial Arts) while in high school; and
 - must be entering a post-secondary program in a construction or building-related profession (carpentry or other construction trade, engineering, architecture, etc.)
- NOTE: Proof of acceptance into a post-secondary program in the fall must be included with the application form.

20. LAKEVIEW INSURANCE BROKERS' SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000)

> <u>Eligibility</u>: The applicant must be a Grade 12 student who:



- will be graduating with a regular Grade 12 Diploma with Honours in June;
- has been accepted into a post-secondary school for the fall and will be pursuing full-time studies in a business, insurance, or finance/accounting related program; <u>and</u>
- submits a short essay of approximately 250-400 words on the following topic: "Explain why insurance and business are important to our economy and society".
- NOTE: Proof of acceptance into a post-secondary program in the fall must be included with the application form.

21. SMOKEHAUS MEATS & DELI SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000)

- Eligibility: The applicant must be a Grade 12 student who:
 - has maintained part-time paid employment while in high school, working for a local business in Martensville for at least 15 hours per week;
 - demonstrates an outstanding work ethic and is considered a hard worker*; and
 - \circ has maintained passing grades while in high school and is on track to graduate in June.
- NOTE: The applicant does not necessarily have to be going on to post-secondary in the fall but *must provide a reference letter from a current employer.

22. WENDY'S FITNESS CENTER (CURVES) SCHOLARSHIP (\$200)

> <u>Eliqibility</u>: The applicant must be a female Grade 12 student who:



- has maintained a good academic standing while in high school by passing her courses and will be graduating with a regular Grade 12 Diploma in June;
- plans to pursue a post-secondary program dealing with health, fitness or well-being within at least one year of graduation; and
- has a helpful personality.
- > <u>NOTE</u>: Students who are taking a "gap year" are

welcome to apply, but if students have applied for a post-secondary program, proof of acceptance should be supplied with the application.

23. The Heck Family Scholarship (\$500)

- Eligibility: The applicant must be a Grade twelve student who:
 - shows athletic leadership by playing on a Royals athletic team in his/her Grade twelve year
 - \circ $\,$ is an academic leader who strives for success in the classroom
 - o is an individual who makes the school, the community, and the world a better place
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- NOTE: the recipient <u>must</u> be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2018.

24. The Rhonda Spracklin Memorial Bursary (\$300)

- Eligibility: The applicant must be a Grade twelve student who:
 - o demonstrates strong leadership abilities
 - o demonstrates financial need
 - o demonstrates perseverance (has overcome an obstacle)
- Preference may be given to a student entering the College of Education or Nursing.
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- NOTE: the recipient <u>must</u> be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2018.
