



# **LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS – 2019/2020**

## **MARTENSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL**

### **Grade 12 Students**

**Application Deadline: Friday, May 22, 2020 by 3:30\***

\*unless otherwise stated

#### **1. Criteria:**

##### **a. Eligibility**

The student must be eligible to graduate and must apply for scholarships by the deadline. Some scholarships require that students be attending school in the Fall of 2020 and some do not. Be sure to read all requirements thoroughly.

##### **b. Application**

All scholarships require an application form. Application forms are available on the Martensville High School Website under “Scholarships” as well as through the daily announcements. Marks will be used as of Grade 12 – Semester One.

##### **c. Submitting Applications**

Applications must be emailed or shared through GoogleDocs to Ms. Cooper at [breanne.cooper@spiritsd.ca](mailto:breanne.cooper@spiritsd.ca) by 3:30 p.m. on May 22, 2020. **In the subject line of your email indicate: 2020 Scholarship Application – Last Name, First Name.**

##### **Include in your email:**

- The completed application form (saved as LastNameFirstNameScholarshipName2020)
- A copy of your acceptance letter (if required)
- Any other supporting material required

#### **2. Receiving the Scholarship Certificate**

After the scholarships have been awarded, you must send a thank you card to be completed and mailed to the sponsor by July 1, 2020.

#### **3. Receiving the Scholarship Cheque**

In August or September 2020, you or your parent/guardian will submit a copy of paid tuition from the post-secondary institution in person or by emailing [breanne.cooper@spiritsd.ca](mailto:breanne.cooper@spiritsd.ca) (email preferred) along with your current mailing address. At this time, your scholarship cheque will be processed and mailed out. You will receive your cheque in the mail approximately 2-3 weeks later.

## SCHOLARSHIPS:

### 1. MARTENSVILLE COMMUNITY RECREATION PROJECT SCHOLARSHIPS – **DEADLINE: MAY 15, 2020**

(up to \$1000)



- The Martensville Community Recreation Project is awarding **\$2,000** worth of scholarship funding.
- *Eligibility:* Applicants must be pursuing post-secondary education in the fall of 2020. Preference will be given to students who have volunteered to help promote sport in the City of Martensville at the community or high school level. This can be through coaching, managing, officiating and growing sports in Martensville.
- Applicants must complete the application form and provide:
  - a cover letter
  - a reference letter (from a teacher, coach, or community member) and
  - a copy of their current high school transcript and second semester mid-term marks (students' average will be calculated based on 8 courses: ELA A30; ELA B30; History 30/Native Studies 30/ or any other 30-level Social Science; a 20 or 30-level Science; a 20 or 30-level Math and 2 other 30-level academic courses).
- NOTE: The recipient must be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2020.

**DEADLINE: MAY 15, 2020**

### 2. BUSTER DAYS COMMITTEE SCHOLARSHIP (**\$200**)

- *Eligibility:* Applicant must be a Grade 12 student who:
  - i. is going into a post-secondary program with a focus on sport, recreation, community development or business; and
  - ii. provides evidence of volunteer work (school-related and in the community) throughout their high school years.
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- NOTE: The recipient must be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2020.



### 3. MARTENSVILLE DENTAL CLINIC SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000)

- *Eligibility:* Applicant must have taken one of the following Math pathways at the 20 & 30 levels (Foundations of Math 20 & Foundations of Math 30, or Pre-Calculus 20, Pre-Calculus 30 and Calculus) **and** all Sciences at the 20 and 30 levels as follows: at least one of Environmental Science 20 or Health Science 20 and Biology 30, and Physical Science 20, Chemistry 30 and Physics 30) and be entering a health science career of some kind.
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- *NOTE:* The recipient must be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2020.



### 4. CITY OF MARTENSVILLE STUDENT BURSARY (\$500)

- *Eligibility:* Applicant must have an accumulated grade-point average high enough to qualify for entrance into a post-secondary program. The selection criteria will include academic merit as evidenced by a significant improvement in academic work and/or a demonstrated and sustained effort to maintain passing grades. Applicant must also provide evidence of involvement in extra-curricular and/or community activities.
- *NOTE:* The recipient must provide proof of enrolment in a post-secondary program within 6 months of graduating from high school.

### 5. BOEHMS' PHYSIOTHERAPY ACADEMIC/ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

- *Eligibility:* Applicants must demonstrate excellence in their dedication to both academic and athletic involvement. Consistent dedication to academics must be present but marks do not necessarily have to be the highest. Involvement in sports, in or out of school as an athlete, coach, or volunteer, must be demonstrated throughout their high school years.
- The recipient will be a future leader in society due to a commitment to sport and academics and will become a role model for young and old, alike.



- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- *NOTE:* the recipient must be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2020.



## 6. MHS STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

- *Eligibility:* The applicant must have made an outstanding contribution to the student body at MHS and have been a member of the SRC for a period of at least one school year during his or her time at MHS.
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- NOTE: the recipient must be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2020.

## 7. RICK CRANSTON SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

- *Eligibility:* The recipient will be a Grade 12 student with honours average in English Language Arts (marks for A10, B10, 20, A30 and B30 combined). The recipient must also demonstrate a passion for English Language Arts.



## 8. KINSMEN SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

- *Eligibility:* Applicant must be a prominent participant in extra-curricular activities that enrich both the school and the community.

NOTE: The recipient must be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2020.



## 9. The Rick Cranston Extra Curricular Drama Award (\$300)

- *Eligibility:* Applicant must be in grade eleven or twelve and exhibit a passion for drama and a dedication to working with the group to make the production(s) a success. The applicant can come from any aspect of the extra curricular drama (stage crew, actor, etc.)
- NOTE: The recipient does not need to be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2020.



## 10. MARTENSVILLE PLUMBING & HEATING SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

- *Eligibility:* The recipient will be a Grade 12 student who (i) participated in the Saskatchewan Youth Apprenticeship Program and/or (iii) completed Apprenticeship or Career & Work Exploration with a work placement in a designated trade while in high school, and (iii) will be pursuing a designated trade after high school.



- To receive the scholarship, proof of registration with the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission must be supplied to the school (MHS) or the student must provide proof of acceptance into a pre-employment program at Saskatchewan PolyTechnic.
- *NOTE:* The recipient must be registered to apprentice in a designated trade by the fall of 2020 or be registered to attend a pre-employment trades program at a post-secondary institution in the fall of 2020. While preference will be given to applicants who will be pursuing a plumbing & heating trade, this scholarship is open to students pursuing any designated trade.

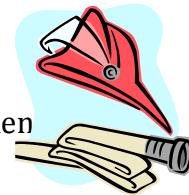
## 11. PROTECTIVE SERVICES SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

- The Martensville Fire Department is pleased to offer a **\$500** scholarship as part of their ongoing community involvement.

- *Eligibility:* The recipient will be a Grade 12 student who:



- (i) will be entering:
- a post-secondary program in the Protective Services field as one of the following: firefighter, EMT or paramedic, police officer, conservation officer, etc. OR
  - the Armed Forces;
- (ii) has been active as a volunteer in his or her community; and
- (iii) is a multi-faceted individual.



- Two letters of recommendation must also be supplied in support of the student's application.
- To receive the scholarship, proof of acceptance into a post-secondary program in a Protective Services field or proof of acceptance into the Armed Forces must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- *NOTE:* The recipient must be registered in a post-secondary program in a Protective Services field by the fall of 2020 or be registered in the Armed Forces for the fall of 2020.

## 12. THE JUDY KOLACH SCHOLARSHIP (\$300)

- This scholarship is provided by the Kolach family (Alvin, Haley and Mary) in memory of Judy Kolach, who was a Special Education Resource Teacher at MHS for many years as well as a teacher and leader in Special Education within other schools in Prairie Spirit School Division.
- Eligibility: Applicant must be a Grade 12 student who:
  - is going on to post-secondary in the fall of 2020;
  - demonstrates involvement in extra-curricular activities while maintaining successful academic standing in high school;
  - has volunteered in the community while in high school;
  - shows a commitment to creating an environment of empathy and kindness; and
  - has overcome or faced a challenge.
- Preference will be given to applicants who will be pursuing a Bachelor of Education program.
- NOTE: The recipient must be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2020.



## 13. THE LOGAN SCHATZ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (2 - \$1000)

- The Logan Schatz Memorial Scholarship is in loving memory of a former Martensville High School Royal who passed away tragically in the Humboldt Broncos bus accident on April 6, 2018. Logan loved all things sport and was a leader and role model on and off the ice. Logan had a zest for life, a kind soul and a smile that would light up any room he walked into. We are honoured to be able to offer a local scholarship in Logan's name to ensure his legacy lives on at Martensville High School!
- Eligibility: The applicant must be a Grade 12 student who:
  - Is a dedicated teammate on at least one sports team (school or community based).
  - Shows strong leadership abilities in and out of sport.
  - Puts effort into his/her classes, but does not have to be a top student.
  - Is a respectful and a kind-hearted role model.
  - Attending post-secondary schooling (university, college, or a trade school) is preferred, but not required.





#### **14. SMOKEHAUS MEATS & DELI SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000)**

- Eligibility: The applicant must be a Grade 12 student who:
  - has maintained part-time paid employment while in high school, working for a local business in Martinsville for at least 15 hours per week;
  - demonstrates an outstanding work ethic and is considered a hard worker\*; and
  - has maintained passing grades while in high school and is on track to graduate in June.
- NOTE: The applicant does not necessarily have to be going on to post-secondary in the fall but \*must provide a reference letter from a current employer.



#### **15. The Heck Family Scholarship (\$500)**

- Eligibility: The applicant must be a Grade twelve student who:
  - shows athletic leadership by playing on a Royals athletic team in his/her Grade twelve year
  - is an academic leader who strives for success in the classroom
  - is an individual who makes the school, the community, and the world a better place
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- NOTE: the recipient must be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2020.

#### **16. St. John's Lutheran Church Bursary (\$500)**

- Eligibility: The applicant must be a Grade twelve student who:
  - demonstrates financial need
- Applicant must provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution when submitting the application. To receive the scholarship, proof of attendance must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- NOTE: the recipient must be attending post-secondary in the fall of 2020.

## 17. Project Change Scholarship (\$500)

- Eligibility: The applicant must be a Grade twelve student who:
  - has been a member of Project Change for a period of at least one school year during his or her time at MHS
  - works tirelessly to spread kindness through volunteering and fundraising in order to make MHS and our community a better place to be
  - believes in the importance of giving back to ones' community
- NOTE: Preference may be given to a student attending post-secondary in the fall of 2020.

## 18. THE ABE REDDEKOPP SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

- This scholarship is in honor of Abe Reddekopp, a man who valued hard work and fairness and who was generous with his time and talent in striving to do his best on each job. Abe was a proud member of the UA Local 179, whose objective is to represent all workers in the plumbing and pipefitting industry in providing the highest standards of quality workmanship and production.
  - Eligibility: The recipient will be a Grade 12 student who (i) demonstrates the characteristics of Abe Reddekopp, (ii) participated in the *Saskatchewan Youth Apprenticeship Program* (iii) completed Apprenticeship or Career & Work Exploration with a work placement in a designated trade while in high school, and (iv) will be pursuing a designated trade after high school.
  - To receive the scholarship, proof of registration with the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission or proof of acceptance into a pre-employment program at a post-secondary institution for the fall of 2020 must be supplied to the school (MHS).
- NOTE: The recipient must be registered to apprentice in a designated trade by the fall of 2020 or be registered to attend a pre-employment program at a post-secondary institution for the fall of 2020. Preference will be given to applicants who will be pursuing plumbing, pipe-fitting, welding, or steam-fitting.





## NEWLY ADDED AS OF MAY 19, 2020

### 19. MARTENSVILLE VETERINARY HOSPITAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

**\*\*DUE: Monday, May 25, 2020\*\***

- Eligibility: This award is given to the student with the highest average in Physics 30, Chemistry 30, and Biology 30. For 2020, first semester marks will be taken as priority in order to determine overall average.
- NOTE: The recipient does not need to be attending post-secondary.

## NEWLY ADDED AS OF MAY 14, 2020

### 20. LAKEVIEW INSURANCE BROKERS' SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000)

- Eligibility: The applicant must be a Grade 12 student who:
  - will be graduating with a regular Grade 12 Diploma with Honours in June;
  - has been accepted into a post-secondary school for the fall and will be pursuing full-time studies in a business, insurance, or finance/accounting related program; and
  - submits a short essay of approximately 250-400 words on the following topic: "Explain why insurance and business are important to our economy and society".
- NOTE: Proof of acceptance into a post-secondary program in the fall must be included with the application form.



### 21. MARTENSVILLE BUILDING AND HOME SUPPLY SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)



- Eligibility: The applicant must be a Grade 12 student who:
  - demonstrates an interest and/or experience in a construction or building-related trade or career path;
  - has taken Practical & Applied Arts B10, B20, and/or B30 (Industrial Arts) while in high school; and
  - must be entering a post-secondary program in a construction or building-related profession (carpentry or other construction trade, engineering, architecture, etc.)
- NOTE: Proof of acceptance into a post-secondary program in the fall must be included with the application form.
