COMMITMENT: Commitment and dedication to the team is of utmost importance.

- Players are expected to demonstrate a "team" mentality and to follow the instructions of the coaching staff.
- Players are expected to attend spring camp <u>to compete</u> for a starting position.
- Players are expected to come to practice on time and ready to play.
- Players are expected to commit to being at every scheduled practice.
- Players are expected to attend all team meetings.

COMMUNITY: All members of the team are also members of the community, having been funded and supported by the community. It is important that at all times, players conduct themselves in a responsible manner, abiding by the law and showing respect to people and property.

FEES: All registration and/or team fees outstanding must be paid prior to the commencement of the regular season. Players are also expected to participate in scheduled team fundraising activities.

DRUGS/ALCOHOL: Royals Football promotes a healthy lifestyle void of drugs, alcohol and/or tobacco products.

SCHOOL: Players are students first. The expectation that players are passing all of their classes, respecting staff and fellow students, and adhering to school policy will directly determine play time during games.

ATTITUDE: The attitude shown by both coaches and players is what will define the team. For this reason, a positive and respectful attitude along with a strong work ethic both at practice and at games will determine the team's success.
