HIGH SCHOOL DRIVER EDUCATION REGISTRATION INFORMATION

SGI has changed the way you complete your Class 7 learner's exam in high school driver education. It can now be done on a computer. The following is what is you need to **COMPLETE BEFORE** you will be admitted to driver ed class.

STEP 1: Obtain an SGI customer number.

- Visit a motor license issuer or SGI branch office.
- Bring 2 pieces of original ID with you to establish your full legal name, complete date of birth, and your signature.
 - Examples: Canadian birth certificate, Canadian Passport, Saskatchewan Health Card
- You will also need **your own email address** (also needed in step 2 below).
 - An email address is needed to activate you MySGI account.
- You will be given a Personal Identification document. **YOU MUST RETAIN THIS.** You will be required to provide this to your driving instructor. To do this, it can be turned into the office with your registration form.
- If you already have an SGI photo ID, you will already have a customer number. At this point, you will need to go to the same office and register your email address (if this has not been done).

STEP 2: Register for MySGI

- Make sure you have added an email to your customer file with SGI. An activation code will automatically be sent to your email account. You will use this code to set up your MySGI account.
- Register for a secure online account by going to www.sgi.sk.ca online and select **Register**.
 - Select **I have an activation code**.
 - Select **Submit**.
 - Provide the required information along with your activation code, the select **Submit**.
 - Create a username and password then select **Submit**.
 - Review and accept the terms of use.
- **It is important to not lose your username and password!**
