### **Welcome! To our New Students**

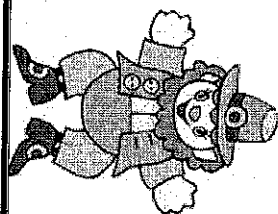
We would like to welcome two new students to our school.

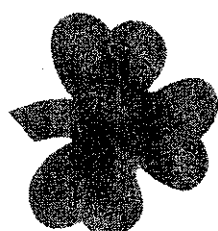
