We are happy to be offering Before and After school care for your community.

We will be starting this program on Monday January 8, 2023. Hours of operation are 7-830am 3-530pm, on school days. Cost is \$15 per half day and \$25 full days, with a cap of \$375 maximum fee per month. Non school days the Vanscoy Early Learning Center may have childcare available on a first come first served basis. Schedules will be required by the 3rd Friday of the previous month to book spaces and to arrange staffing. Payment will be due by the first week of the month. \$50 deposit toward fees will be due before start date. Two weeks notice for cancellations. If you are interested in subsidizing fees, there is a bottle program available through Sarcan.
