Farewells

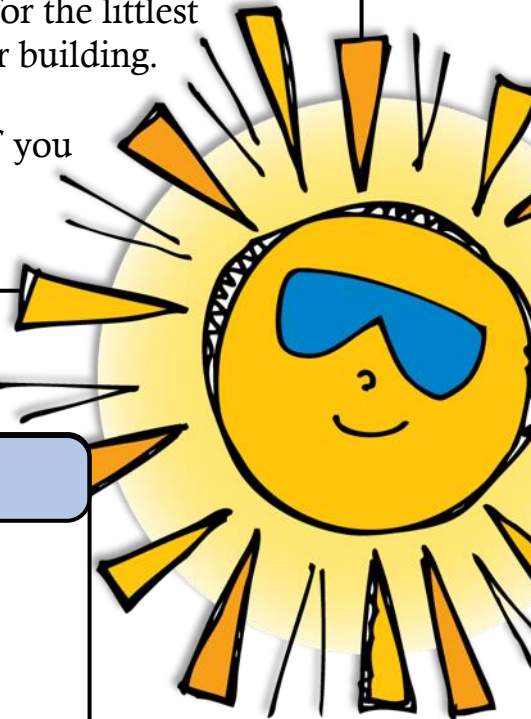

School Supplies

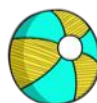
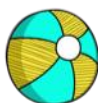
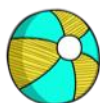
