We want to take this opportunity to send out some additional information and reminders before students head back to school on Tuesday!

STUDENT ARRIVAL GUIDELINES

- All students should have received an email from their homeroom teachers regarding the “soft start” dates that they will be attending next week (all students are attending **either** Tuesday/Thursday or Wednesday/Friday). If you do not have this information, please contact Miranda.isaak@spiritsd.ca or phone the school (306 232 4868).
- All students will enter the school using their designated doors (as outlined in the [RCS Safe School Plan](#)). With the exception of PreK/K students, all students will be entering from the “back” of the building – no students will be entering at the main front doors.
- Students driving themselves are welcome to park in the student lot (accessible from Highway 312).
- Parents who wish to drop off students should do so curb-side on 4th Street. Please **do not drive into the bus loop**.
- Homeroom teachers for grades 1-12 will be outside to provide guidance to students as they arrive.
- Please try to arrive as close as possible to **8:45am**.

RECENT UPDATES TO THE RCS SAFE SCHOOL PLAN

- Morning recess will now be staggered for grades 1-6 (4 grade groups outside at one time).
- Lunch times are also staggered for grades 1-6:
 - Grades 1-3 eat from 12:15-12:35 and go outside from 12:35-12:55.
 - Grades 4-6 go outside from 12:15-12:35 and eat from 12:35-12:55.
 - Students who go home for lunch are asked to return to school as close to 12:55 as possible.

ADDITIONAL REMINDERS FOR FAMILIES

- Students in grades 4-12 are **required** to wear masks whenever it is not possible to maintain a social distance of 2m – this also applies in classrooms when social distancing is not possible.
- Students in grades preK-8 are not permitted to have cell phones at school.
- Students in grades preK-8 are required to have indoor shoes to change into when they arrive.
- Smoking and vaping are not permitted on RCS grounds at any time.
- Hats may be worn indoors by students in grades 4-12.
- Lockers are not currently available for students in grades 4-12. Please bring as few items to school as possible at this time.
