As the year continues, students will start hearing words like learning intentions (which describe what students are learning in each class) and success criteria (which identifies what they should know/understand at the end of a lesson). This ongoing work helps students to have more ownership of their learning, and also helps teachers to target the unique needs of individual students. We are lucky to have teachers who are so willing to learn, grow, and care deeply about each student in their class!

January is an especially important time of learning for our students in grades 9-12 who will be writing midterms and final exams at the end of the month. Students in grade 10 will be completing their first set of "credit courses" which contribute toward graduation – if parents have any concerns about students who might be in jeopardy of not successfully completing a class, we encourage them to contact classroom teachers ASAP!

As we continue to create a safe learning environment at RCS, we want to remind all families of the following:

- · RCS is still at "Level 2" of the Saskatchewan Safe Schools Plan, meaning that full in-class learning is available for all students. Online learning is only available for students who are required to self -isolate.
- · Students in all grades are still required to wear masks throughout the school day.
- · Water fountains are not available for students, so we are requiring all students to bring a water bottle to school (the bottle filling stations are available).
