The following information is being shared with members of the Rosthern Community School community. Since this pertains to the health of members of our community, please be respectful with this information.

We received reports today of a positive COVID-19 test result for individuals in our school connected to the following classrooms (please note that one case may be connected to more than one class):

Class/Bus/Activity	Date of positive test
Grade 5/6 Class	Wednesday, January 19
Grade 6 Class	Wednesday, January 19

If you have a child in an identified classroom/bus/activity, please see the <u>General Risk of Exposure communication</u> for further information.

Students and staff members in the listed classroom(s) are considered a close contact for 10 days from the date of the positive test result, unless not in attendance for two full days prior to the date of the positive test result.

- **Unvaccinated students** who are not experiencing symptoms may attend class but must isolate from all extracurricular activities and outings.
- **Unvaccinated students** who are close contacts of a household member who has tested positive for COVID-19 are not exempt from self-isolation. These students must stay home and not attend school.
- Fully vaccinated students and staff who are not experiencing symptoms are not required to isolate.

Classes in the school will continue as scheduled until further notice.

All students and staff members at the school are asked to <u>self-monitor</u> for symptoms daily. If your child has any symptoms of COVID-19, they must not attend school, even with a negative test result. If you or your child have any symptoms of COVID-19, please call HealthLine at 811 and remain at home.

Thank you for your continued partnership as we work to keep schools healthy and safe for students and staff.

We will continue to provide additional information to parents/guardians as it is available.
