The following information is being shared with members of the Rosthern Community School community. Since this pertains to the health of members of our community, please be respectful with this information.

We received reports of positive COVID-19 test results for individuals in our school connected to the following classrooms/busses/extra-curricular activities (please note that one case may be connected to more than one class):

If you have a child in an identified classroom/bus/activity, please see the <u>General Risk of Exposure communication</u> for further information.

- Students in the listed classroom(s)/buses/extra-curricular are considered a close contact for 10 days from the
  date last attended by the individual with the positive COVID test. Date last attended is counted as Day 0 of the
  isolation period.
- Unvaccinated/partially vaccinated students who are not experiencing symptoms may attend class but must isolate from all extra-curricular activities and outings for 10 days from the date last attended by the individual with the positive COVID test. Date last attended is counted as Day 0 of the isolation period.
- Unvaccinated/partially vaccinated students who are close contacts of a household member who has tested positive for COVID-19 are not exempt from self-isolation. These students must stay home and not attend school.
- **Fully vaccinated students and staff** who are not experiencing symptoms are not required to isolate. Classes in the school will continue as scheduled until further notice. We will provide more information about the impact on extra-curricular activities, if applicable.

All students and staff members at the school are asked to <u>self-monitor</u> for symptoms daily. If your child has any symptoms of COVID-19, they must not attend school, even with a negative test result. If you or your child have any symptoms of COVID-19, please call HealthLine at 811 and remain at home.
