Pandemic research

Last spring, you may have been one of the 510 families across Saskatchewan who shared their experiences of the pandemic with a team of researchers and mental health practitioners at the University of Saskatchewan through an online survey called "See Us, Hear Us". The purpose of that survey was to understand how the first year of the pandemic affected families, their mental health needs, and how well these needs were being met.

This spring, the research team is inviting children and youth (8-18 years) and their parents/caregivers to take part in their new See Us, Hear Us 2.0 survey. You don't need to have taken last year's survey to participate. The focus this year is on understanding young people's mental health, well being, resiliency and needs for mental health services and support at this stage of the pandemic.

2022/23 School Year Calendar

Prairie Spirit students will begin the 2022/23 school year on Thursday, September 1, 2022, as determined by the school year calendar recently approved by the Prairie Spirit Board of Education.

The Ministry of Education directed school divisions to use a pre-Labour Day start date for the upcoming year to appropriately schedule the required number of instructional hours.

The calendar was developed in consultation with stakeholder groups as well as other area school divisions. The calendar represents a total of 181 instructional days for all students, with 950 hours of instruction.


There is no school on Friday, September 30 for the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.

There is no school for students on Wednesday, November 9 (Teacher Preparation day), Thursday, November 10 (school holiday) and Friday, November 11 (Remembrance Day). The other days set aside for Teacher Preparation and Professional Development are detailed in the calendar.

The final day of the 2022/23 school year for students will be Thursday, June 29, 2023.

Key dates include:

- First day for students: Thursday, September 1, 2022
- Christmas Break:
 - Last day of classes Thursday, December 22, 2022
 - Classes resume Monday, January 9, 2023
- February Break:
 - Last day of classes Friday, February 17, 2023
 - Classes resume Monday, February 27, 2023
- Easter Break:
 - Last day of classes Thursday, April 6, 2023
 - Classes resume Monday, April 17, 2023
- Final day for students: Thursday, June 29, 2023



Information for the fall.....

Homeroom teachers will be emailing their students during the week of August 24th-31st to let their students know what classroom they will be in.

Also Grades K-6 will be on a \$40 supply fee per student, meaning the school will purchase all necessary supplies and families will not need to provide. This is a significant cost saver for families and helps to have the same items that the teacher requires.
