

## Parents and Guardians: You can take advantage of our Text Messaging Service

**SchoolMessenger will be sending you an opt-in text message in the coming days if you are one of the first three contacts listed for a student in Prairie Spirit School Division. This is a replacement for the previously used “SwiftK12” messaging system.**

Our division utilizes the SchoolMessenger system to deliver text messages straight to your mobile phone with important information about events, school closings, safety alerts, and more.

You can either wait for the opt-in message and reply, or you can choose to participate in this free service\* just by sending a text message of “Y” or “Yes” to our division’s short code number, **978338**.

You can also opt out of these messages at any time by simply replying to one of our messages with “Stop”.


We recommend saving this short code and Caller ID to the contacts on your phone. This will help prevent any 3rd party call blocking systems from interfering with your receipt of important messages sent by the school or district.

SchoolMessenger is compliant with the Student Privacy Pledge™, so you can rest assured that your information is safe and will never be given or sold to anyone.

 *Information on SMS text messaging and Short Codes: SMS stands for Short Message Service and is commonly referred to as a “text message”. Most cell phones support this type of text messaging. Our notification provider, SchoolMessenger, uses a true SMS protocol developed by the telecommunications industry specifically for mass text messaging, referred to as “short code” texting. This method is fast, secure and highly reliable because it is strictly regulated by the wireless carriers and only allows access to approved providers.*
