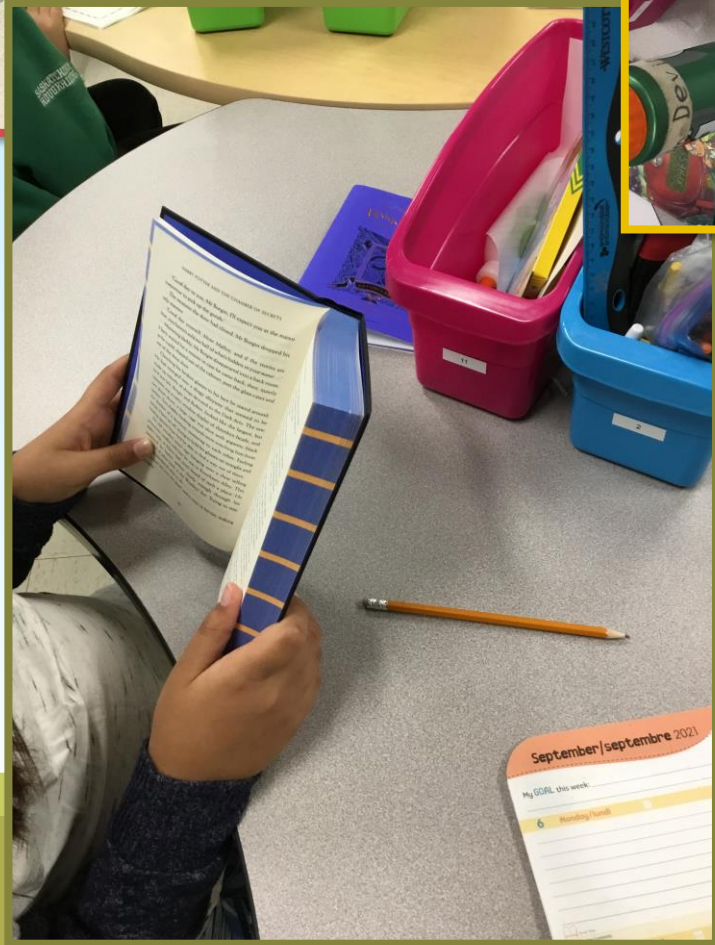
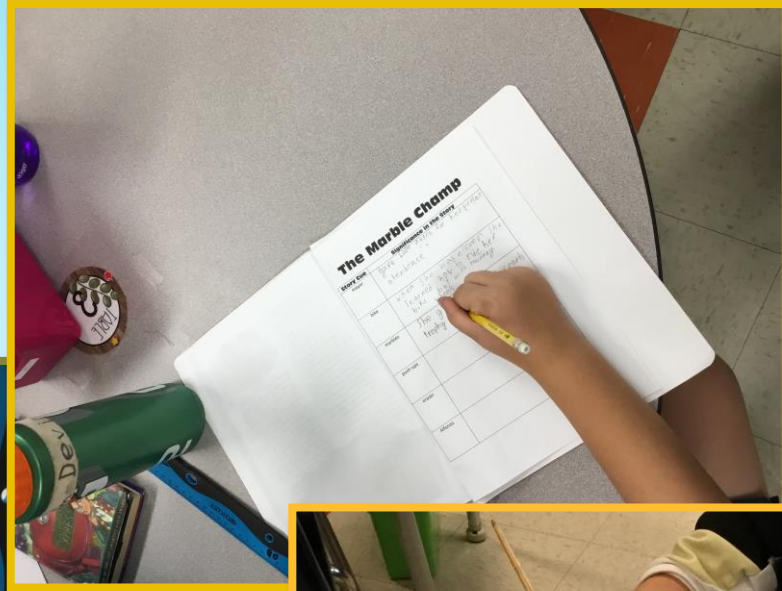
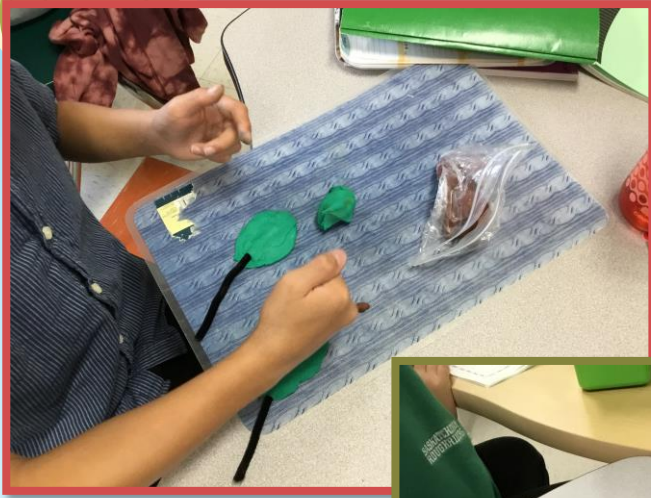




As The Year Progresses...
