
The SCC would like to welcome new and returning families to South Corman Park for the 2024/2025 School Year!

  - encourage parent, community and youth engagement in school planning and improvement.


### Roles & Responsibilities

- SCCs may also provide advice and recommendations to their boards of education, school staff and other organizations about the learning needs and well-being of students.



The SCC has a goal to support our school and students through its continued growth. This goal will be achieved through the following Prairie Spirit framework:


What are some activities that could support and promote student well-being?

With the growth of our school we are always exploring new ideas and activities to connect to our students and enhance their learning experience.


