	picture). It is the students job to figure out how many dots are underneath the		
	splat, and how they know. For example, you can see there are 8 dots outside		
	the 'splat,' which means there are		

The questions I ask at school are: How many dots are underneath the splat? How do you know? How could you use this information to write <u>four</u> number sentences?

- 8 + 4 = 12
- 4 + 8 = 12
- 12 4 = 8
- -12-8=4
