Please spend time reading, writing, creating, exploring, and being physically active each day.

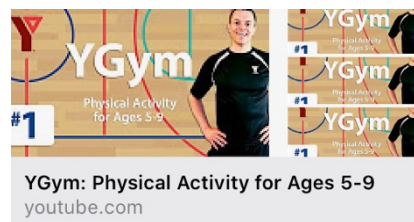
Get outside and enjoy the beautiful spring weather!!

This could look like:

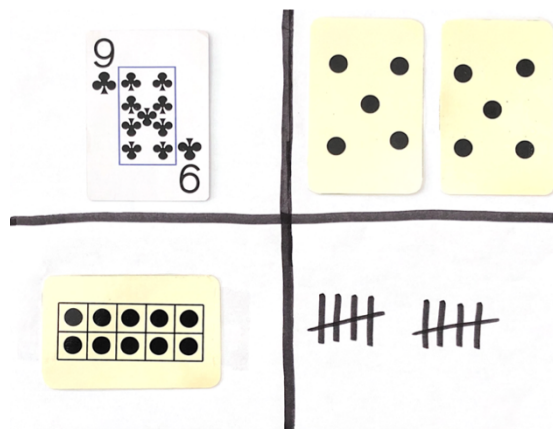
Can you solve the morning message?

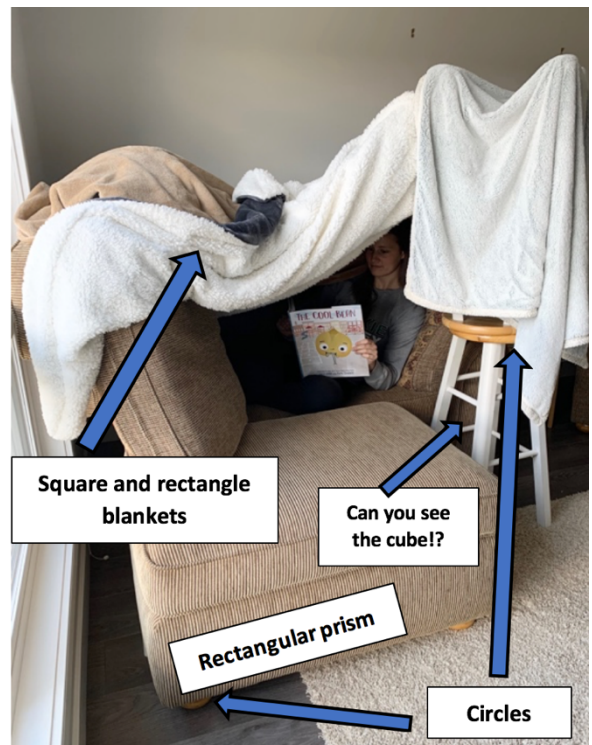
Make a fort to read in this week!

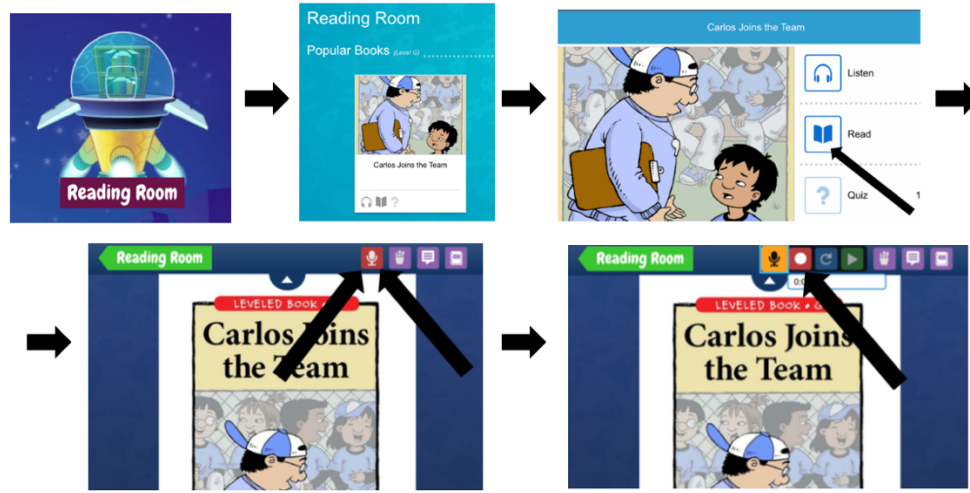

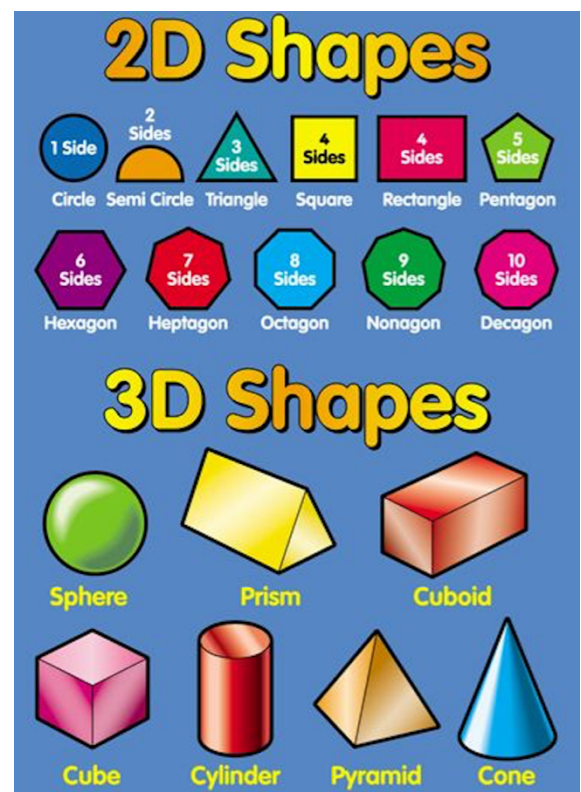

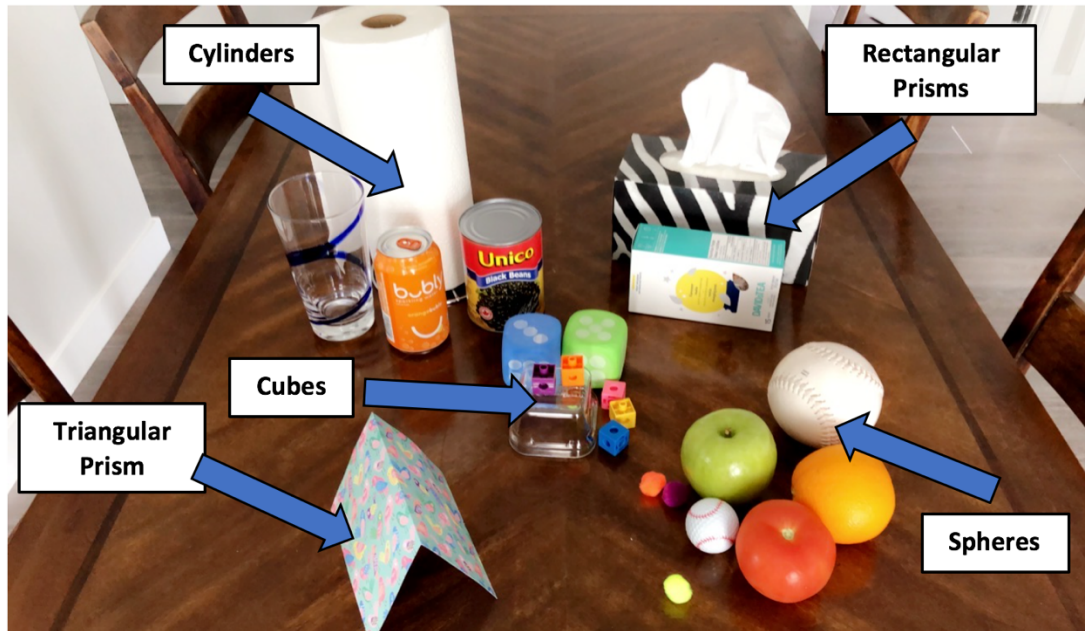
