Complete some summer writing using the provided bucket template!

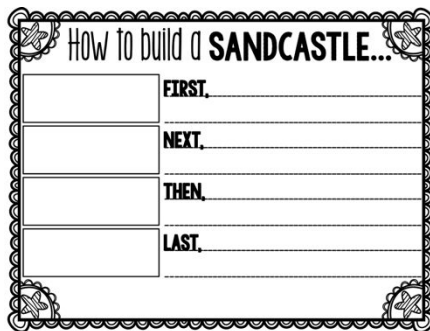
Use the template provided to write about your plans for the summer. This template will be attached to the weekly email as well as available for download on our class website. Once you're finished the writing, colour your bucket!
