4. Business arising from minutes:
 - a. Teacher Appreciation
 - School was sent questionnaires that were shared with the school via the newsletter.
 - Flowers were delivered to teachers today.
 - Sugar cookies will be shared with the teachers on Wednesday.
 - Carlene will forward the total costs to Quinton once tallied. Costs will be shared at the next meeting.
 - b. One Book One School
 - Books were sent home today.
 - 182 books were ordered, this includes the 5 extras, 3 of which have already been spoken for.
 - There is one question sheet that has to be submitted by March 1, 2022.
 - On March 4th there is a big celebration for the kids related to One Book One School. Stay tuned!
 - For prizes, it was decided gift cards will be issued.
 - b. Literacy Program Idea for Future – A month of themed books where each week kids try to read a different kind of book based on the theme. (IE – Read a book about snow). The Committee recommended that this be

discussed again in December 2022 meeting to be planned for end of January 2023 when it is literacy week.

a. School Administration (Mr. Tebay & Mr. Howie)

- SLT – Student Leadership Team – Limited to grade fives, with each class getting a third of the school year to plan activities for the school. The second group of grade fives began planning activities. Their first activity they wanted to do was Winter Olympics. This will be followed by next week's spirit week!
- The teachers did reflections for the Learning Wall in January. A lot of great information was added.

b. PSSD Board (Adin)

- January was a very busy month with respect to the pandemic. The School Board continues to work with local health officials.
- Reminder to continue to follow protocols, stay home when sick, and report when you are ill.
- Working on renewing the division's Strategic Plan. A survey already went out for Warman and Martensville, the feedback was great and will go in to the Strategic Plan.
