1. Welcome and Call to Order – 7:01 P.M.
2. Adoption of Agenda
  - a. The agenda for December 5, 2022, was approved as presented.

3. Review and Adoption of Minutes
  - a. The minutes for November 14, 2022, were approved as presented.

4. Business Arising from Minutes
  - a. Christmas Concert
    - December 14<sup>th</sup> (KA, 1, 2) and December 15<sup>th</sup> (KB,3,4,5) are the dates for the Christmas concert.
    - There will be a dress rehearsal in the afternoon at 1:15pm and an evening performance at 7pm each day. Each performance is open to families to attend. The SCC will be providing hot chocolate and candy canes after each evening performance.
    - Kim purchased 4 containers of hot chocolate and marshmallows. Greg will plug in and start heating the large percolators of water at 5:30.
    - Kim, Leanne, and Charity will arrive at 6:30pm on Wednesday (Leanne and Charity on Thursday) to mix and pour hot chocolate for after the performance.
    - Carlene purchased 1600 candy canes.
    - Leanne will purchase 2000 Styrofoam cups.
    - There will be donation boxes outside of the gym for the Warman Food Bank. Charity will decorate some empty boxes.
  - b. One Book One School
    - Twyla read the book “A Boy Called Bat” and recommends it for One Book One School. Twyla and Greg will look into ordering books in the new year with the plan to run the event in February or March.
  - c. Winter Reading Project
    - An idea was suggested to do a reading project this winter for the students (like what Warman Community Library did with book themes each week, etc). This has been tabled until 2023.

    - Attendance was down 10-15% each day a few weeks ago due to illness but attendance has since returned to normal.
