- Do you have an infant or child, age 0 to 18 years of age?
- Does your child need dental treatment?

If you have answered “**yes**” to the above questions, your child may be eligible to receive dental treatment at the Population and Public Health Dental Clinics at **no charge**.

To be eligible for services, children/youth must:

- live in the Saskatoon Health Region.
- have obvious dental problems that require treatment.
- have limited or no dental coverage. If the child has some dental coverage, we will ask parents/guardians to bring the dental insurance forms with them to the **first** appointment.
- Not have used the dental clinic services before.

Oral health is important! Healthy teeth and gums help you to chew properly, speak clearly, and smile brightly.
