The number of COVID cases in Saskatchewan continues to rise. The Government of Saskatchewan announced new public health measures that will come into effect on **Friday, November 27**: COVID-19

To align with these new expectations and to continue to support safety in our schools, the following changes will be implemented in Prairie Spirit schools, starting on Friday:

- Students in **Pre-K to Grade 3** will wear masks throughout the school day. Students should come to school with at least one non-medical mask. The school will have disposable masks available for students, if required. We will work with our younger students to help them build their stamina
- All students and staff will wear masks throughout the school day (except when eating and drinking).


Our teachers and school staff will support all students to understand and follow these new measures. We appreciate your support as you guide your children at home.
