4. Business arising from previous minutes:

- a) Communication – Facebook- Jasmine will work to push out information that is passed along in newsletters or on PowerSchool.

 - 2019 Leftover- 1 flat Sprite, 1 box burgers, 1 box chips, 1 package of cheese (Reagan will purchase remaining items and write a cheque to the school to deposit)
 - Feedback for next year- consider moving BBQ to the Thursday before the long weekend to allow families to meet staff and drop off school supplies, provide vegetarian option, wonders around a pre-order
 - Discuss in March possibility of new BBQ date
- d) Books for a Better World and books for classrooms- Tabled to October
- e) Bible Knowledge
 - Phased out due to new admin procedure
 - Lisa met with Connor Shram and let him know of the change in AP
 - Connor may contact Sam Dyck for more information
 - Considering an afterschool club

f) Field Trips

- Each grade grouping developed a field trip plan including approximate dates, fundraising needs, and budget
- Grade 6 will ask parents for \$44, Grade 7 \$53, and grade 8 \$63
- SCC appreciated the advanced notice
- \$10 will go to each student from Fundscrip and the school budget- this is accounted for in the cost breakdown
