Upcoming School Year

Each spring school staff undertake a thorough and careful process of placing students in homeroom groups for the next school year.

A great number of factors go into this decision including academic, behavioural, and social needs, programming and timetabling factors, supports for special needs students, and safety considerations. In some cases, students/families are accustomed to processes where they are asked about specific peers they would like in their classroom for the upcoming year. At the middle school level, we continue to take social/relationship factors into careful consideration when making class groups, but do not ask students for friends lists as we are unable to make any guarantees about this.

If parents feel their child has a unique need to be considered in the class placement process for the upcoming year, we encourage parents to initiate a conversation with the classroom teacher before May 11th.
